GO 4 Schools mobile app

We are excited to announce that the GO 4 Schools mobile app is now available to enable you to view on your smartphone or tablet the following information on your child:

Timetable

- Summary of current lesson and the next lesson
- More detailed information on your child's daily timetable including timings and teachers

Homework

- New tasks set
- Tasks due today, tomorrow and within 7 days
- Extended pieces of homework set
- You will be able to click on homework pieces to access detailed explanations, links and attached documents

The GO 4 Schools App can also send to your smartphone and/or email address summary notifications/emails on the homework set so that you are fully informed. You can change your preferences in the app settings. These notifications will also appear in your message inbox in the App or in your online inbox on the Go4Schools website.

To login to the GO 4 Schools App, your username and password are the same as the GO 4 Schools site. The App is a great way to keep in touch with your child's timetable and homework. Don't forget however, you can also login to the main GO 4 Schools site for more detailed information including RATE information, progress reports, behaviour and attendance.



MyEd mobile app

Please note that all communications from the school (that were previously sent home as letters) will continue to be sent through the MyEd app or by email for those without it. Student absence can also be reported through the MyEd app

MyEd app can be downloaded on any Android or Apple smartphone. A secure area of the app ('My Students') is only accessible to the phone of one parent/ carer who is recorded as a student's first point of contact in the school database. You will receive all communications from the school in this secure area (ie. brief urgent messages that were previously via text and printed letters that were previously sent home via students). It is important that notifications from this app are allowed so that updates come through to you immediately. In some cases we will ask you to respond via the app. Absences can also be reported through the secure area. If you are unable to download the MyEd app for any reason, we will send brief urgent messages via text and letters via email.
