Dear Parents, Carers and Students

GCSE results will be available on **Thursday 21 August**: you may pick them up **in person at the Sixth Form Centre between 9:00 am and 11:00 am**, or view them on the Bromcom/MCAS app from 2:00 pm. If you would like a parent or another adult to collect your envelope, please email Mrs Lisa Gidney (l.gidney@huxlow.northants.sch.uk) by Wednesday 20 August, naming the person who will attend; they must bring a photo ID on the day.

Whilst on site all students are encouraged to speak to a member of staff regarding their next steps, whether that is to stay on at Huxlow and Rushden Academy Sixth Form or take part in post 16 provision elsewhere. Those intending on staying on at sixth form must have their photo taken for their ID before they leave. In case of the possibility of a paper remark or review, students will need to sign a permission slip.

To celebrate there will be areas in the sixth form set up for taking celebratory photos, having refreshments and sharing success with peers and staff.

If a student is unable to attend results day please contact Lisa Gidney, our exams officer, to inform her as to who will pick up the results on their behalf.
